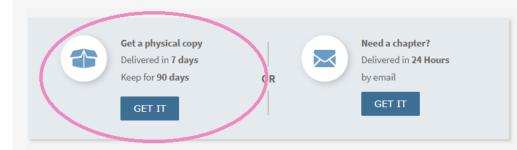


Rapido at NTU

- Soft launch June 2023
- Full launch from October 2023
- Part of the UK Pod with 5 partner libraries
 - 7-day delivery time
 - 90-day loan period
 - Max 2 renewals
 - No recalls

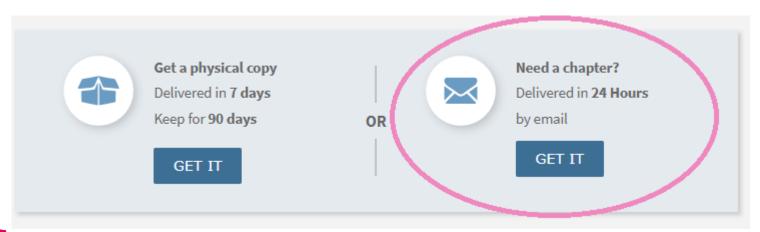

 - 24-hour delivery time



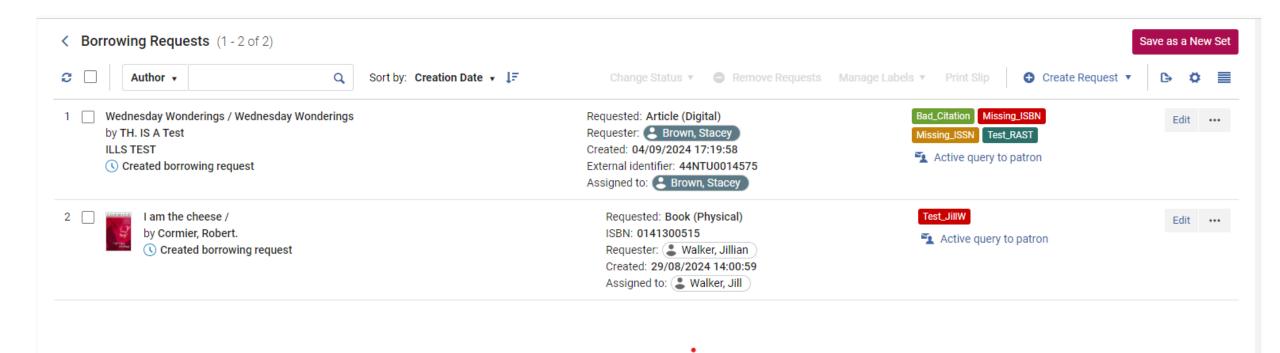

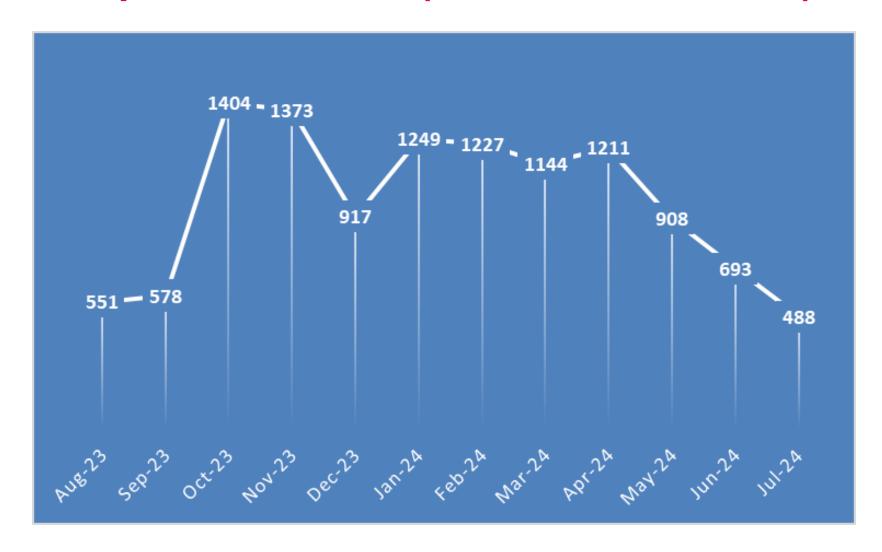
Borrowing Requests





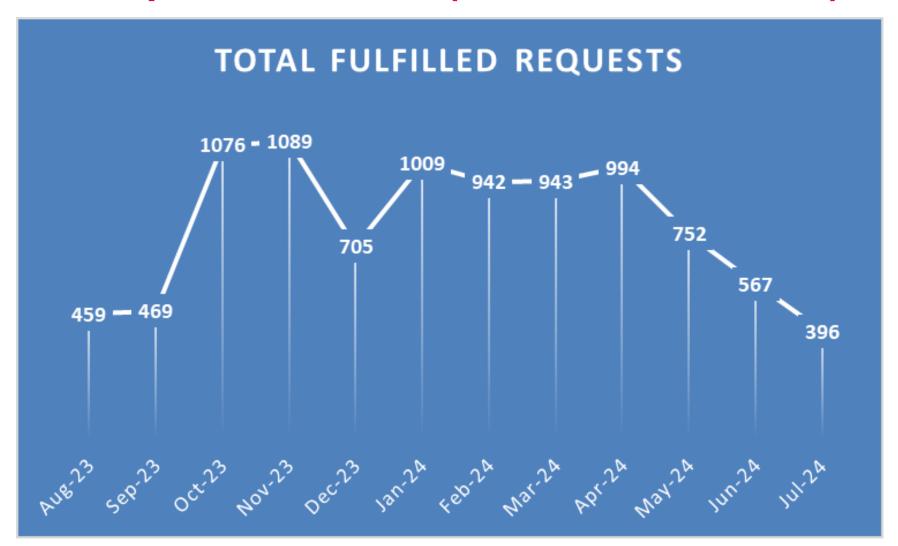


Total no. of requests received (01/08/24 to 31/07/24): 11,743





Total no. of requests 'fulfilled' (01/08/24 to 31/07/24): 9,401

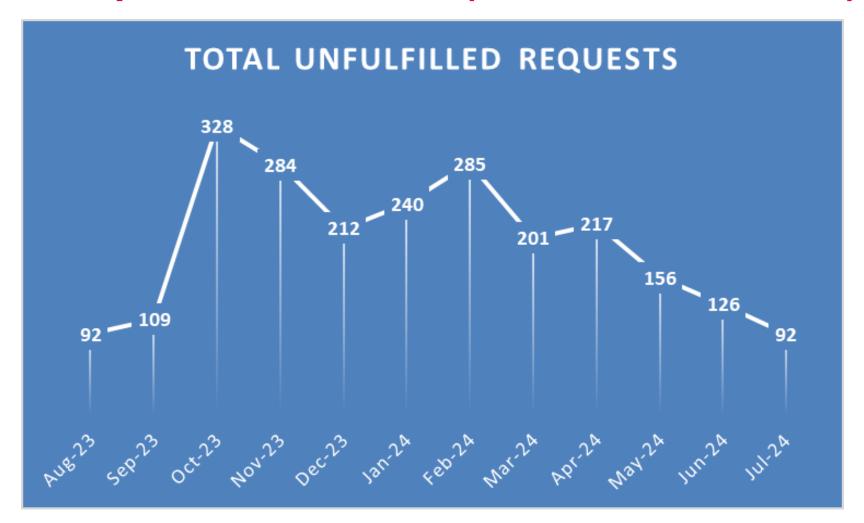








Total no. of requests 'unfulfilled' (01/08/24 to 31/07/24): 2,342





Rapido/RapidILL

- 6009 items 'fulfilled'
- 5753 via RapidILL
- 256 from our partner libraries (Rapido [26 digital items supplied])
- 73% 'fulfilled' automatically, 27% required staff intervention...
- 230 physical (whole book) items supplied by pod partners required staff intervention to receive, renew and return



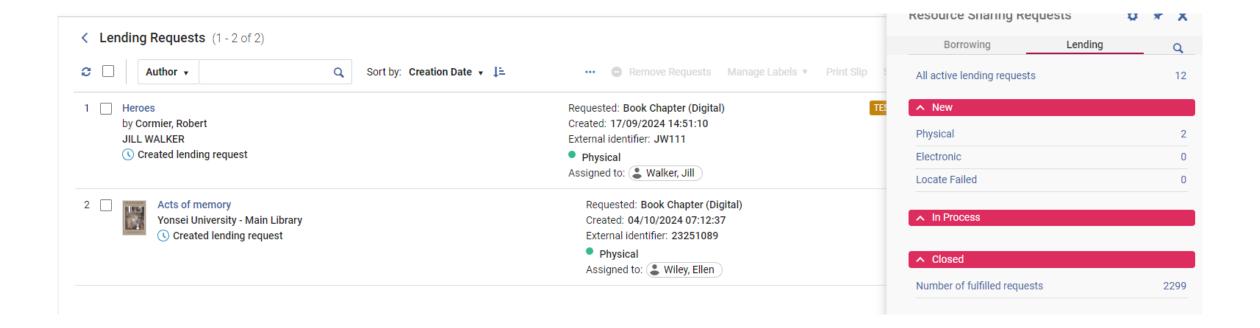
British Library

- 31% of items supplied via British Library for AY 22-23
- Less than 1% supplied via British Library for AY 23-24
- Borrowing from other libraries reduced by 60% from 22-23 to 23-24

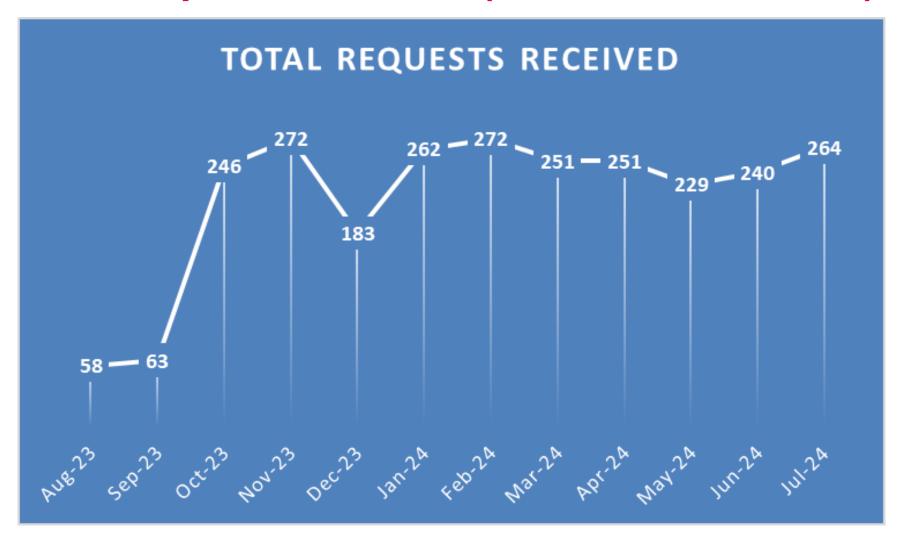


Lending Requests



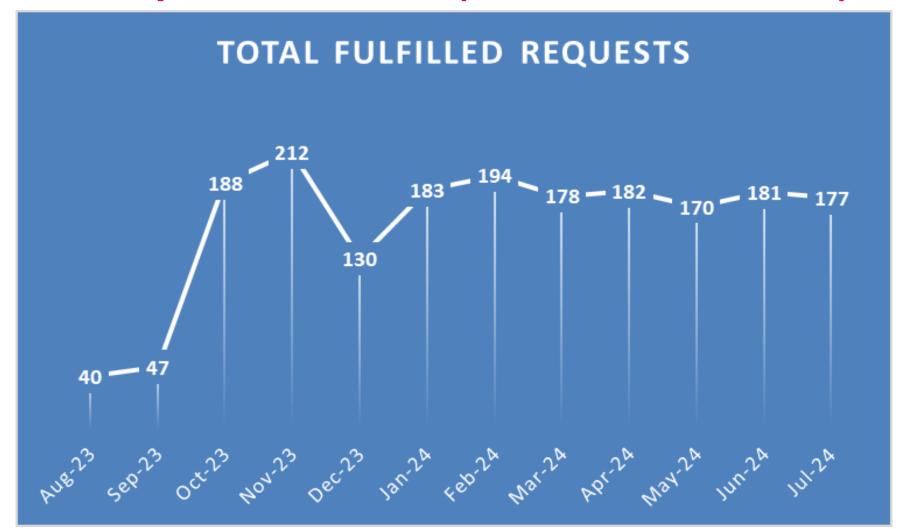


Total no. of requests received (01/08/24 to 31/07/24): 2,591

In summary...

- Total requests received = 2,591
- 73% requests 'fulfilled' (81% of those that could be...)
- 10% of all requests received lack copyright compliance
- 18 requests were cancelled by borrowing institution
- 50 physical items were sent to Rapido UK pod partners (23 requests from UK Pod members were rejected, 9 of those 'in error' and 3 duplicates, so 11 which is still 15% - mostly because the content couldn't be found or we do not own)
- 1,832 chapters/articles sent worldwide
- 440 physical resource types so can assume we have scanned these ourselves = 1 to 2 scans per day



Other Rapido/RapidILL considerations



Things we've done so far...

- Reviewed and rewritten patron letters
- Create analytics reports
- Create sets to streamline monitoring of requests
- Trialing 'automatic' claim
- Internal testing of 'Enrich from global index'
- Internal testing of 'search in market' (integration with Rialto)





Things we hope to do...

- Review and reduce cancellation reasons for borrowing requests
- Review and reduce rejection reasons for lending requests
- Create analytics reports
- Extend collections available to lend
- Partner data tidy
- Mediation rules?
